ANALYSIS OF SEMANTIC IN LYN LAPID SONGS

ABSTRACT

Song is a short poem or other set of words set to music or meant to be sung. By listening to the songs, we can get knowledge about appreciating literature and the background of the song. The objective of this study is to analyze the lexical meanings and the contextual meaning in Lyn lapid song lyrics that are "In My Mind" and "Itsy Bitsy". The aim of this discussion is to try to make sense of the song lyric from the side view of semantic meaning: lexical meaning and contextual meaning. The step to obtain the data is by collecting sources of the data from Lyn lapid song's lyrics that are "In My Mind" and "Itsy Bitsy Spider" that has been posted in youtube. After that selected the lyric which contain of semantic, reads and listens to the lyrics to understand the content of the songs conducts and analyzes the collected data and makes conclusion. The result of this research is as follows: (1) related to the lexical meaning, while (2) related to the contextual meaning.

I. Introduction

A branch of linguistics that learns about the meaning of linguistic expressions that are semantic. With semantics we can know how and what is the meaning of the lyric in literal or in contextual. It means that meaning in linguistic semantics was needed for us to limit ourselves to the expression of meanings in a single language. Semantics is one of the important branches of linguistics, and deals with interpretation and meaning of the words, sentence structure, and symbols. It deals with the reading comprehension of the readers, in how they understand others and their interpretations.

In addition, semantics constructs a relation between words and clarifies the sense of a sentence, whether the meanings of words are literal or figurative. In the semantics there is a kind of meaning that is lexical and contextual (Britannica, 2017)

Lexical meaning refers to the sense (or meaning) of a word (or lexeme) as it appears in a dictionary. Also known as semantic meaning, denotative meaning, and central meaning. Contrast

with grammatical meaning (or structural meaning). The branch of linguistics that's concerned with the study of lexical meaning is called lexical semantics (Longman, 1992)

Contextual meaning is a linguistic meaning in context. (Longman, 1992). For example the meaning of a word is in a sentence or a sentence is in a paragraph. For example, the sentence "They come out to play" can mean literally they came just to play but in this case, Lyn Lapid talked about her thoughts that always come in her head. This research is focused on the meaning of the lyrics that are Lexical meaning and contextual meaning that appear in the lyrics of Lyn Lapid song, those are "In My Mind" and "Itsy Bitsy". In this study, song lyrics are the data that is analyzed. The lyrics are collected from the Lyn Lapid songs, those are "In My Mind" and "Itsy Bitsy". Katelyn Lapid or commonly known as Lyn Lapid is an American singer and songwriter of Filipino descent. She gained popularity on the video sharing app TikTok, where she recorded covers of various songs, and teased her debut single, "Producer Man".

There are hidden messages or meanings in the song lyrics. The first song tells about the overthinking situation of the person and second is about someone who can't escape from his past. These songs give us how overthinking can impact how it works. Song lyrics use non familiar or uncommon language, compared to the word used in daily conversation. Sometimes the listener can misunderstand the lyrics. While the listener knows the meaning of the lyrics, it will have its own opinion. Therefore, people will translate or interpret it by their understanding without knowing the truth of the purpose of a composer. Beautiful words will have valuable meanings and require the ability to deliver ideas through semantics

II. Methods

This research applied Descriptive qualitative methods. Qualitative description (QD) is a label used in qualitative research for studies which are descriptive in nature, particularly for examining health care and nursing-related phenomena (Polit & Beck, 2009, 2014).
